

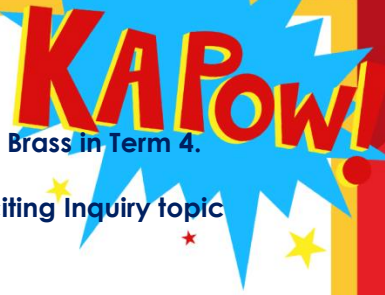
YEAR 3 NEWSLETTER- TERM 3 WEEK 9
